Audiology	Audiologists are the first step for hearing health care. They aim to prevent hearing loss. They can assess, diagnose and treat hearing disorders. Child and Family programs - Allied Health Services	Allied Health Services including occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Podiatry, Exercise Physiology, Speech Pathology, Nutrition and Dietetics, Counselling/psychology, Social work and Family Support. Eligibility: those who live, work or study (or the child goes to pre-school or child care) in Greater Dandenong, Casey or Cardinia. These services also support people who cannot get to or use services in their local area. Services see children in 'out of home' care as a priority. There is no fee for those on health care card, low income, Aboriginal or refugee clients. Dental Services	General dental services are offered at the Monash Health Community Sites. Children and young people in 'out of home' care may be seen as a priority. This will be worked out on a case by case basis. Please let the receptionist know when you call that the child or young person is in 'out of home' care. Maternal and Child Health	Maternal and Child Health Services are for all families with children from birth to school age. Families attend 10 Key Age and Stage visits. Most of these are at their local Maternal and Child Health Centre where staff: do regular child health and development checks and screens, link families with other services and give information and tips on a range of parenting topics. Services also help families who need higher levels of support within their home.	Multiple sites across Greater Dandenong, Casey and Cardinia. Support may be provided in a variety of settings, including the family home, the maternal and child health centre, or other locations within the community. Orthodontics	The Royal Dental Hospital offers reduced cost orthodontic care for children and young people in 'out of home' care. The cost is spread out on a payment plan that can be flexible. Sexual and Reproductive Health Nursing Clinics	Health Assessments/ family planning/ contraception concerns, reproductive health checks (eg pap smears), breast health, pregnancy tests, unplanned pregnancy options, termination information, referral and counselling, Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) and Blood Borne Virus (BBV) education, health education and referrals to health services. Youth Health Hub	For vulnerable young people aged 16-25 years. At the hub, young people can use a range of services including: Exercise Physiologists, Social Workers, Dieticians, Psychologists, Music Therapists and Communications/Speech Pathologists. Eligibility is open to vulnerable young people who live, work, study or visit services in the Cities of Greater Dandenong, Casey or Cardinia (and surrounds).
